Narrative

Overview:

The proposed program MSA MSL Next Pro Stadium and Training Facility propose a program that reflects the highest standards of design and functionality, aligning with MLS standards for stadium development while catering to the unique needs of an MLS Next Pro team. This venue is envisioned as a premier Next Pro stadium, accommodating 7,500 to 10,000 spectators with an intimate and vibrant atmosphere for soccer matches. Beyond its primary role as a soccer-specific stadium, the facility is conceived as a multi-use complex that serves as a hub for daily training, conditioning, education, and nutrition, preparing youth athletes for the next level of play.

The design incorporates spaces for the operations and growth of professional teams, featuring flexible lockers and conditioning facilities that can accommodate a second team in training, such as an NWSL or Super League women's soccer program. Front office spaces for these teams, along with offices for stadium operations, ticketing, community outreach, and team administration, have been thoughtfully integrated into the program to support the organizational needs of a modern sports complex.

While soccer remains the heart of this venue, its flexibility is a core design principle. The stadium is capable of hosting other sporting events, concerts, conferences, and community gatherings, ensuring its role as a dynamic and versatile community asset. Every element of the design emphasizes functionality, efficiency, flexibility, fan engagement, environmental responsibility, safety, security, and convenience, creating a venue that not only meets but exceeds MLS standards.

This initial program establishes the criteria for the design and construction of the DC United Next Pro Stadium and Training Facility, setting the stage for a world-class complex that stimulates attendance, enhances the fan experience, and maximizes commercial opportunities, ensuring its success as a flagship facility for the sport and the community.



Stadium **Seating Bowl**

General The venue prioritizes the safety of spectators and game participants, including players, referees, and staff in accordance with MLS standards. Seating will be positioned as close to the field as possible to create an intense and intimate stadium atmosphere. Key considerations include maintaining high-quality views and ensuring the appropriate rake of the seating bowl. The impact of field obstructions, such as advertising boards, team benches, and broadcast personnel, must also be carefully evaluated. However, some level of obstruction may be deemed acceptable to achieve optimal proximity to the field and enhance the overall atmosphere. Additionally, it is essential to understand the fan base and identify where specific portions of the home team's supporters will prefer to view the game.

Calculations Riser Height and Depths will be designed with MLS Standards in mind with no

greater than a 34-degree rake.

Tiers

Base Bid- 7,500 spectator seating with canopy over seating areas on west and south end. Lower bowl 5,000 seats, Upper West Grandstand Seating 2,500

Expanded seating scenario (Base Bid Alternate 1) provides an upper-level seating stand with canopy. Expanding bowl capacity to 10,000 seats. Lower Bowl 5000 Seats, Upper West 2,500 seats, Upper East 2,500 seats

The seating bowl may be organized into multiple distinct tiers. The venue will ensure a clear separation between standard reserved seating and premium seating, which can be achieved through tiered levels or other design strategies.

Premium seating is centered along the touchline and positioned on the side of the stadium that receives the least glare during games the Western Stand. Depending on the stadium's size and layout, an upper reserved seating tier may be considered as an upgraded seating experience.

Press Level -the upper level of the western side of the field also provides circulation, amenities and access to the upper level of seating noted in the Base Bid.

The club will include premium seating with direct sightlines to the field, a full-service bar, and a catering kitchen capable of supporting various dining styles, from buffets to plated meals.</p> <p>State-of-the-art audiovisual equipment, including large screens, projectors, and sound systems, will enable the space to support presentations, live broadcasts, and entertainment. The club will feature comfortable lounge areas with high-quality furnishings and private restroom facilities, all designed to create a sophisticated and welcoming atmosphere. Meeting all ADA accessibility requirements, the club will ensure inclusivity with ramps, elevators, and appropriate accommodations for</p>

individuals with disabilities.

With direct access to the field, the club will maintain an exclusive connection to the stadium environment while ensuring privacy and security for event attendees. Natural light will be maximized through large windows or retractable walls, complemented by customizable interior lighting for evening functions. The adaptable design will make the club suitable for corporate events, weddings, community gatherings, and educational seminars, creating a dynamic and profitable space that enhances both the game-day and year-round stadium experience.

The club will also be adjacent to the Media Interview room to provide a view to the media/interview room for post-game experience.

Club Seats	The stadium is designed to include at least one additional premium seat category in a mid-level location with exclusive access to a private club, ensuring that club access is integral to the experience. A minimum of 1,600 Club Seats is recommended.
Club Lounges and Bars	The venue is designed to include premium and exclusive lounge(s) and/or bar(s) for Club Seat holders. The number and exact locations of these amenities are determined by the market, seating configuration, and other relevant factors, and they are appropriately sized with a recommended minimum of 10-15 gross square feet per person. These spaces include outdoor areas, concessions, restrooms, and are located close to premium seating sections.

Adequate power must be provided to support magnetometers and other security equipment, and sufficient space should be allocated to facilitate orderly queues for guests awaiting screening. Floor finishes will be non-slip for safety, and concourses will be designed with a very low fire load to enhance fire safety and compliance with local codes.

Premium Seating 6 sf per person to meet MLS Standard.

Exiting from Field Vomitories providing field-level access are designed to meet the exiting requirements for an anticipated field-level occupancy of 7,500 standing-room-only attendees in a concert configuration. The number, width, and placement of the vomitories are determined based on the expected crowd size, stage configuration, and seating area layout. The design will ensure safe and efficient routes in compliance with ADA standards, while also providing the required minimum light levels to adequately illuminate the paths of travel.

Press Level concourse The upper west seating level will be accessed from the press level concourse. Concourse will be designed to meet the 4 sf per person MLS minimum standard.

The stadium will also comply with all applicable state laws on the provision of restrooms. The required minimum ratios for fixtures are as follows: MLS standards typically exceed the ratios noted by Local Code.

Distribution Male and female restrooms are to be distributed evenly around the stadium, or otherwise in a manner that matches the seating distributions within the bowl, to minimize travel distances from all parts of the venue. Janitor closets should be included to serve each pair of toilets.

Flow To ensure free flow of spectators, the design will follow MLS recommended criteria that restrooms are designed to have a one-way access system (entry and exit) or a wide enough single entry to allow people to pass comfortably.

Family Restrooms The family restrooms will be equally distributed around each concourse at a ratio of approximately 1 per 4,000 spectators. These restrooms are designed to provide accessible and inclusive facilities for all guests, including ADA-compliant features such as wheelchair access and appropriate fixture heights. Each family restroom will include a hand wash basin, a water closet, and baby changing facilities to accommodate a variety of needs and ensure a comfortable and convenient experience for all spectators.

Stadium Hospitality and Guest Services

Multi purpose Lounge This 1,000-square-foot space is designated as a flexible multi-purpose lounge designed for private events or pregame activities, catering to the needs of an MLS Next Pro stadium. Separate from the Club Lounge, this space will feature direct access to the main concourse and exterior access, allowing for the integration of natural light. The lounge will be equipped with counter space for catered events, as well as amenities to ensure guests remain connected to the action on the field, making it a versatile and dynamic addition to the stadium experience. On non game days the space can be rented out as a private conference space, community activities or by the teams as a second learning space.

First Aid A dedicated First Aid room is provided to ensure accessible medical care. The First Aid room is easily accessible from all spectator concourses and to emergency vehicles, clearly signposted for identification, and designed to allow wheelchair and stretcher access. The room will be equipped with an exam table and curtain. Also within the space will be a single accessible restroom. A small counter with lockable storage, sink and under counter refrigerator will be provided for storage of supplies. .

Guest Service	A customer service counter will be provided to assist spectators during events and will be easily accessible from all concourses. Ideally located near ticket booth entrance area.
Lost and found	A counter for spectators to recover or hand in lost items will be provided, in accordance with MLS recommendations. The location of this counter will be clearly identified and may be combined with customer service .
Sensory Space	The stadium will include a dedicated sensory space designed to provide a calming environment for spectators with sensory sensitivities or those in need of a quiet, controlled area. This space will be equipped with features such as soft lighting, sound-dampening materials, and comfortable furnishings to create a soothing atmosphere. Additional resources, such as sensory tools, noise-canceling headphones, and weighted blankets, may be provided to enhance comfort. The sensory space will be ADA-accessible and located to ensure convenient access from all areas of the stadium. Staff trained in sensory support will be available to assist guests as needed, ensuring an inclusive and welcoming experience for all spectators.
Mothers Room	The Mother's Room will provide a comfortable, private, and functional space for nursing mothers or those caring for infants. It should be centrally located within the stadium for easy access from concourses and seating areas, while being positioned away from high-traffic zones to ensure privacy. The space is ADA-compliant, offering accessibility for individuals with disabilities and accommodating strollers or wheelchairs. Amenities such as comfortable seating, a diaper-changing station, a sink with running water, and storage for personal belongings. Electrical outlets, including USB ports, should be provided for breast pumps or other devices, while soft, dimmable lighting and independent climate controls enhance comfort. The room should have a lockable door for privacy with an occupancy indicator and be monitored as part of the stadium's overall security plan. Designed for flexibility, the Mother's Room should accommodate nursing, bottle feeding, and other caregiving activities, creating a welcoming and inclusive environment that enhances the stadium experience for families.
Drinking Fountain	Drinking fountains and bottle filling stations will be provided in compliance with local, state, and federal codes and regulations, as well as MLS standards.
Flag Poles	3 flag poles will be provided as per MLS requirement to be viewed from the spectator seating areas within the bowl.
Stadium	Food Services/Concession Stands
General concession	The stadium's food service is divided into two primary categories: general patron service and premium service for club suite or premium patrons. General food service consists of fixed concession counters and portable carts or specialty stands strategically located throughout the stadium to ensure convenient access for all guests.
Premium	Premium food service includes suite catering, along with clubs, bars, and restaurants strategically positioned throughout the facility to offer unique dining and bar experiences with exceptional views before, during, and after stadium events. Additional food service facilities will be provided to meet the needs of staff, press personnel, and teams or performers, ensuring comprehensive support for all event participants.
Traditional Concession	The size of the traditional concession area is determined in part by the number of Points of Sale (POS). It is essential to maintain the correct ratio of POS to spectators to prevent overcrowding in these areas. MLS standards require a minimum ratio of 1 POS per 150 spectators. This should be supplemented with portable food and beverage outlets in addition to Just Walk Out Market Places.

The specific size of the concessions will depend on the type of food and beverage offerings, but as a general guideline, an allowance of 5 linear feet of concession area per linear foot of POS, along with corresponding support space, is recommended as an initial estimate.

Typical Stands have a patron facing space with counter and roll down door, with a back of house prep/cooking space with appliances, sinks and storage racks. 50 % of the concessions will be vented for cooking-loaded on the exterior side of concourse.

Electronic menu boards to be incorporated for flexibility. Power and POS connections to be provided at all Concession Locations no matter the type.

Distribution and queuing	Concessions will be evenly distributed around the concourse in accordance with MLS recommendations or aligned with the seating distribution within the bowl to minimize the distance spectators must travel to access them. Adequate space will be allocated for queuing in front of points of sale (POS), as required by MLS. To prevent congestion, a clear channel will be provided for guests to exit smoothly after collecting their food and beverages. Where space allows, lateral queuing systems are recommended for improved efficiency.
Storage	There will be storage spaces on each stadium side for general game day storage for game day access and storage.
Just Walk Out	The option of incorporating the cashless Just Walk out Technology will as an vending opportunity in lieu of traditional walk up/order experience. These JWO spaces can be configured to be drinks only, drinks and grab and go snacks, or hot food could be prepared at the stand or stocked from the catering kitchen. Integration of the JWO technology requires upfront technology integration.
Portable Stand	The facility will consider enhancing permanent concession operations with portable food service or beverage carts. Concourses will be designed to accommodate potential future cart locations, incorporating power and data connections as part of the planning process.
Custodial	Concession stands will have janitorial support spaces one in each quadrant. Typically a place for mop sinks and cleaning equipment storage.
General Notes	<p>Food Service/ Commissary Kitchen Support</p> <p>The commissary will be located on the event level with direct access to the loading dock to ensure efficient operations. In multi-level stadiums, a dedicated freight elevator will be provided for food service distribution. The commissary will include walk-in refrigerators and freezers, a main beer pump room, a liquor storage room, managers' offices, dry storage, and cart storage rooms to support the venue's food and beverage operations.</p> <p>The commissary will primarily serve public concession stands, specialty carts, and kiosks. However, it can be configured to include separate areas for both general concessions and suite/club catering, depending on the preferences of the stadium management and food service operators</p>
Pantries	Pantries are adjacent to the space they are serving. ie Suite/Club. The pantries will be evenly dispersed. No cooking will occur in the pantries, the pantries are for final food prep and warming plus liquor/beer storage.
Press Pantry	The press pantry will be located on the upper concourse, adjacent to the press box areas. This pantry will be designed for buffet-style food distribution for working press and media. While no cooking will take place in the pantry, it will serve as a space for final food preparation and warming.
Kitchen Office	The commissary office will include workspace to accommodate five staff members in an open office plan. Also provide a dedicated counting room or vault for secure financial operations
Kitchen	Provide space for kitchen staff to securely store their belongings. 18" lockers and

Custodial Provide custodial area for equipment, storage and mop sink to maintain the spaces adjacent to main catering Kitchen.

Main Catering Kitchen

The main catering kitchen will be located adjacent to the suite and club restaurant, serving both the suites and club areas as well as catering needs for back-of-house staff, including press, officials, and visiting teams.

Stadium Vendor Restaurant/Pub

Supporter Pub Intended primarily for recognized supporter groups and adjacent to endzone supporter zone, the space will evoke a beer hall or sports bar atmosphere. The flexible seating arrangement both interior and exterior will be capable of hosting a variety of event on non-sporting days.. This standalone building is envisioned as a community hub, offering unfinished interior allowing easy interior planning and coordination and planning for the vendor's unique requirements. Ideally leased to an outside operator, the pub will operate independently on non-sporting event days, establishing a year-round destination for fans and the surrounding community.

Retail Space The team store will be located at street level, providing direct access to both the main concourse area and the street, allowing it to operate during stadium off-hours. This facility may serve as a combined retail space for all the stadium's primary sports teams, ensuring a convenient and versatile shopping experience for fans. The space will be finished out with base flooring, wall and ceiling treatments. The future vendor to design, plan and install the retail display fixtures to their vision.

Stadium Locker Rooms

Home/Visiting Team **Team Locker Rooms**
The Home Team Training spaces are designed to provide state-of-the-art facilities that support player performance and team operations. These spaces include locker rooms with premium finishes, ample storage, and dedicated areas for coaches and staff. Training areas, such as weight rooms, hydrotherapy, treatment rooms, nutrition, social and strategies are integrated to ensure optimal player preparation and recovery. Meeting rooms equipped with advanced technology are provided for team strategy sessions and analysis. Additionally, these spaces are located for efficient access to the field while maintaining privacy and security for the team.

Each Athletic locker room provides thoughtful layouts to ensure functionality, comfort, and professionalism for both home and visiting teams. These spaces meet the demands of daily training of home teams or hosting visiting opponents, reflecting the facility's role as a premier venue for Next Pro Soccer. Home and Visiting Locker rooms provide identical features

Locker Area:

30" Individual lockers for 25 players, with secure storage, power and ventilation. (2 lockers accessible)

Each locker provides space for personal belongings, uniforms, and gear. One outlet per locker with charging capabilities.

Lockers will have integrated seating or a bench area to maximize space.

Team Meeting Area:

A dedicated meeting space within or adjacent to the locker room, equipped with seating for all players and staff.

Audiovisual equipment, such as screens, projectors, or monitors, for strategy discussions and game analysis.

Restroom and Shower Facilities:

Restrooms with a minimum of 8 individual stalls

A separate grooming area adjacent to toilets with a counter, 8 sinks, and dedicated outlets for electric shavers and hair dryers, space to set out qtips, mouthwash, toothpaste, lotion, etc

Shower facilities with at least 8 individual shower stalls, ensuring ample availability and privacy post-game or practice.

Coaches' Office:

An attached or adjacent office for coaching staff with lockers, desks, seating, and AV capabilities for pre- and post-game reviews.

Dedicated Room with non-gendered accessible shower, lavatory and toilet

Storage:

Closet storage space for team equipment, training gear, and supplies.

Amenities:

A small kitchenette or refreshment station with counter space for game day nutrition/hydration stations, sink and undercounter refrigerator.

Comfortable, durable flooring to handle heavy use and provide comfort.

Design Considerations:

Efficient layout to ensure smooth flow and accessibility for all users.

High-quality finishes and fixtures to reflect the professional standards of NextPro Soccer.

Climate-controlled environment for player comfort and optimal performance

Stadium**Lockers: Game Officials****Officials Locker Room**

The facility will include two non-gendered officials' locker rooms to accommodate both male and female game officials, with the capacity to support doubleheaders by providing separate spaces as required. These locker rooms will be designed to ensure a sufficient degree of separation and privacy from the home and visiting team locker rooms, as well as from media areas. Direct access to the field will be provided, allowing officials to lead both teams onto the field while ensuring separate and secure access to their locker rooms when they exit the field. This design prioritizes privacy, efficiency, and professionalism for game officials.

Officials Locker Area:

Five (5) 30" Individual lockers for 25 officials, with secure storage, power and ventilation.

Each locker provides space for personal belongings, uniforms, and gear.

Lockers will have integrated seating or a bench area to maximize space.

Officials Toilet/Shower Area

Dedicated Room with two (2) non-gendered accessible showers, lavatories and toilets

Stadium**Green Room/Home Team Family Room**

The stadium's green room will accommodate the needs of performers, speakers, or special guests, providing comfort and functionality before and after their appearances.

A counter space for catered food and beverages will be integrated into the design, allowing for seamless hospitality and pre-event refreshments. The counter should have sink, microwave and under counter refrigerator.

Additionally, a dedicated makeup counter with proper lighting and mirrors is provided to support touch-ups and preparations.

Comfortable seating and furnishings will create a relaxing environment, while durable and stylish finishes will maintain a professional aesthetic. Located in close proximity to performance or event spaces, the green room will serve as a versatile and essential feature for enhancing the overall experience for event participants.

This room will also accommodate Player families during Sporting Events.

Green Room Toilet/Shower Area

The green room will include a private accessible restroom and shower, ensuring convenience and privacy for occupants

Event Staff

Lockers Event Staff

The stadium will include dedicated locker rooms, restrooms, and a break area for event staff, designed to provide comfort, convenience, and functionality during operations. The locker room will feature secure individual lockers for staff to store personal belongings and uniforms, with durable finishes to withstand heavy use. Adjacent restroom facilities will include sufficient stalls, sinks, and amenities to accommodate the staff efficiently, maintaining hygiene and accessibility standards, including ADA compliance.

Staff Locker Area:

Thirty (30) 18" w double tier lockers secure storage and ventilation. Each locker provides space for personal belongings, uniforms, and gear. Lockers will bench area to maximize space.

Staff Restroom:

Adjacent or within the staff Locker area will be a non-gendered restroom with lavatories and toilets.

Staff Break Room:

The break area will be an efficient comfortable, multi-functional space where staff can relax and recharge during shifts. It will include seating, tables, and small kitchen amenities such as a microwave, refrigerator, and coffee station to support meal preparation and storage. The design will ensure easy access to these facilities from key operational areas of the stadium, fostering a supportive environment that enhances staff well-being and efficiency during events.

Home Team Training Space

The Home Team Training spaces are designed to provide state-of-the-art facilities that support player performance and team operations. Training areas, such as weight rooms, hydrotherapy, treatment rooms, nutrition, social and strategies are integrated to ensure optimal player preparation and recovery. Meeting rooms equipped with advanced technology are provided for team strategy sessions and analysis. Trainers Office/Locker Room –

A shared office will be provided for the Athletic Trainers with clear views of the

treatment and hydro areas. The office will have room for 3 desks with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves, and a sitting area with a small conference table. This office will also require a TV, marker boards, and LED game clock in it. 1 touchdown station will be provided for assistant trainers and interns. 3 open lockers for quick changes/personal belongings.

Medical Exam Room

This multi-function room will be a private area for exams, massage, acupuncture or any other individual player treatment needs. This space will be equipped with exam table, upper and lower lockable cabinetry with sink and full-size locking refrigerator for drug storage, lightbox reader and clock.

Toilet

Non Gendered toilet/shower area for Trainer area Accessible equip with one open locker to be used as an alternate changing space.

Closet

Space to be used by janitor and staff for storage of cleaning equipment and other items

Stadium

Team Training Strength and Conditioning

Training Areas

The indoor portion of the Team Training Area should be naturally lit, with high ceilings and designed to be column-free to the extent possible. The outdoor portion should be tented or covered with no walls

Weight Area

The weight room will be near the player locker rooms and will have direct access to the practice fields and training areas. Mirrors will be provided on interior walls where possible. A recording table will be provided for players' strength and conditioning charts. Notice boards will be located adjacent. A towel distribution and collection station will also be provided. A Visi cooler for bottled water and other drinks will be provided along with an area for snacks such as power bars. The room will have TV monitors, game clock, full A/V capability and will be acoustically separated from other areas

Stretch and Recovery

Dedicated space and table for weight bearing stretching and exercises. Equipment storage racks.

Turf Area

Provide a dedicated zone within the Training space that is equipped with professionally installed turf material that matches the stadium surface material.

Cardio Area

This zoned area adjacent to the weight room will be provided for cardio equipment (including AlterG). TVs and full A/V capability will be provided in the cardio areas. Provide wall mounted marker boards and game clock

Athletic Trainers Office/Locker Room –

A shared office will be provided for the Athletic Trainers with clear views weight and cardio space. The office will have room for 3 desks with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves, and a sitting area with a small conference table. This office will also require a TV, marker boards, and LED game clock in it. 1 touchdown station will be provided for assistant trainers and interns. 3 open lockers for quick changes/personal belongings. The Head Strength Coach will ideally have a view to the weight room, Cardio room, and practice fields. The Head Strength coach's office will have room for a desk with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves. This office will also require a TV and a bulletin or marker board in it

Storage

A storage room will be provided with direct access from the weight room. Rack

shelving will be provided

Stadium **Team Training Coaching / Development**

Team Meeting /Video Room

This space will be equipped with advanced technology providing a space for team strategy sessions and analysis. Equipped with theater style seating with a tablet space for notes or computers. The ceiling and wall walls should be Acoustically treated for sound isolation. The space will be equipped with advanced technology providing a space for team strategy sessions and analysis. Wall mounted white boards for strategy sessions.

Media/Podcast/Broadcast Room

Workspace with monitors for reviewing taped games and practices. In addition, a space equipped with Podcast features for two people. Walls will be designed with acoustical isolation in mind.

Head Coach Office

The office for the Head Coach will have a work area with the Coach's desk but also an area to meet with visitors with a couch, 2 side chairs, TV, and a coffee table. The office will also have a private restroom accessed from within. The office will have a view of the field or training space.

Head Coach Office-Restroom

Accessible space provided with locker, shower, water closet & lavatory.

Assistant Coach and Staff Shared Office and Locker

An open office/war room space will be provided for the Assistant Coaches adjacent to Head Coach. The office will have room for 3 desks with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves, and a sitting area with a small conference table. Space will have a view to the work out areas or hallway. This office will also require a TV, marker boards, and LED game clock in it. 1 touchdown station will be provided for assistants and interns. 3 open lockers for quick changes/personal belongings. The space will also provide Three (3) lockers and boot rack.

Assistant Coach Office-Restroom

Accessible non gendered space provided with open locker, shower, water closet & lavatory within or close access to the Assistant Coach Office.

Storage Closet

A storage closet room will be provided for the coaching staff area with adequate shelves and cabinetry.

Stadium **Team Training Classroom/Lounge/Kitchen**

Kitchen Nutrition

This will be used to provide space to prep, cook and store food for team training days 2 meals daily. The fully functioning kitchen will be provided with cooktop, oven, dishwasher, full size fridge/freezer, icemaker, dishwasher, microwave, separate beverage cooler, pantry and associated HVAC and exhaust system.

A full-size refrigerator with freezer space and full-size storage cabinet should be anticipated for each team in training. This space should have two access points, one team dining area separate to the hallway.

Team Dining/Flex Learning Area

The team Dining Flex area is a space for Team Nutrition. Provide Casework for buffet style serving of team meals (60 people). Space should be naturally lit with generous views of the stadium or practice pitch. If possible, provide access to outdoor patio areas and exterior seating/dining options. The space will be open and furniture flexible to be

utilized for more than dining, youth education and presentations. Provide chalk and dry erase board, video capability, wireless internet access, dividable into two (2) spaces

Classroom/Lounge

This area should be designed for players to be able to comfortably sit in a communal environment to relax, eat, etc. Lounge seating, tables/chairs, ping pong table, TV, sound system. It will also provide tables for breakout meetings or study sessions for 30 visiting youth. Provide chalk and dry erase board, video capability, wireless internet access, dividable into two (2) spaces

Breakout Nooks

Small Study areas or breakout nooks to be provided for focused learning, built in tables and bench seating with lowered acoustical ceiling, sound absorbing wall coverings will provide a space for focused learning or meetings.

Team Training /Equipment Manager Spaces

Equipment Manager Spaces: The Equipment Room should be conveniently accessed from the garage and be directly adjacent to the players' locker room areas. In addition to the areas specified below, the room should have a desk for the Equipment Manager.

Storage: The Equipment storage room will include shelving, hanging racks, and bin storage. Space saver storage will also be considered in the equipment storage room. The room will incorporate racks for storage with space underneath for the trunks to be easily loaded/unloaded and stored. Corridor space outside the trunk storage area will be wide enough to stage loaded carts prior to loading on trucks

Uniform Area

This secured Uniform room will be used for uniform storage, uniform selection, numbering and fittings for new players etc. It will include shelving and bin storage.

Uniform Printing

The printing area should provide deep cabinetry to hold uniform print machines and dedicated power for devices. Open shelving above and below for all supplies.

Laundry Room

Laundry area will provide for a of three (3) industrial washers and two (3) industrial dryers due to the day-to-day needs of Teams in training at the facility. Storage racks and space for supplies and equipment for multiple spaces

Boot Room

Dedicated space adjacent to entry/exit to outside team training area for ventilated boot racks holding minimum of 35 pairs of cleats. Built in bench for seated players min 12' in length.

Janitor

Provide Janitor closet adjacent to Equipment manager with mop sink and shelving

Stadium

The box office will be a dedicated area for game day/event ticket disbursement and cash management with secured entries

Provide ticket windows at a ratio of at least 1:3,500 spectators with the ability to expand based on the assessment of the event.

General Managers Office

The private office will have room for a desk with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves, and a sitting area with a small conference table. The office will also include a TV, marker board, and LED game clock. Offices should be positioned to maintain visibility to the open office spaces. Storefront glazing facing open office space. Ensure acoustic privacy with soundproof materials to mitigate distractions from open office spaces.

Facility Managers Office

The private office will have room for a desk with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves, and a sitting area with a small conference table. Storefront glazing facing open office space. The office will also include a TV, marker board, and LED game clock. These offices should be positioned to maintain visibility to the open office spaces.

Marketing/Sales/ Community Outreach

The shared office will have room for three (3) desks with two chairs for visitors, a cabinet with shelves, and a sitting area with a small collaboration table. The office will also include a TV, marker board, and LED game clock. These offices should be positioned to maintain visibility to the open work area with storefront glazing facing open office space.

Open Work Area

This large open workspace/war room area is designed for collaboration and flexibility

Conference Room

A main conference room will be provided with a conference table and chairs for up to 12 occupants. The room will be provided with TV monitors, full A/V capability and white markerboard walls. The conference room will be located adjacent to the reception area.

Copy/Supply/Work Room

Work room designed with upper and lower counters and hefty power for electrical equipment. Provide two work spaces with flexible seating.

Break Room Kitchenette

kitchenette, tables, and chairs to accommodate approximately 4-6 persons.

Event Storage

Storage is provided adjacent to the field and Loading Dock. Storage is to be Divided into lockable cages, for field equipment, signboards, signs, banners and other decor, field maintenance equipment. Where feasible, storage space should have 11' ceilings at minimum a.f.f. to allow forklift access. All doors to Storage areas are to be roll up doors or A height of 6' W x 10'-0"H AFF to allow Fork-lift access. .

Sand and Turf Storage Provide sand/turf material storage that is easily accessible by the field maintenance crew for required applications.

Chair storage in rolling racks to allow easy access for event set up and take down. If possible, store in vertical racks.

Field covering stored in the service yard with direct access to the exterior and the field. (natural turf)

General Building Storage

Security

Control Room

Space allocation for 24/7 building security (Control Room) to include the ability to monitor CCTV coverage, access control, weather monitoring, and building communications (radio base, PA, in stadium assets).

Unified Command Center

MLS requires the provision of a Unified Command Center to effectively manage resources and communication during an event.

MLS requires the provision of a Unified Command Center to effectively manage resources and communication during an event. The space also allows integration with

First Responders in the event of an incident to respond and recover. The space shall be designed based on a Unified Command model. At a minimum, the Unified Command Center shall have:

- A clear and unobstructed view of the field and seating bowl.
- Full power and internet access.
- Specific access control.
- Designated seating for staff.
- Space for at least four monitors (weather, in house, field cams, and an independent screen);
- Space for a map of the venue and a dry ink panel; and
- Connections to all video surveillance systems from the Stadium Security Control (24/7)

Detention Area

The room(s) should provide space for Club staff, stadium security personnel, and/or police to process paperwork for any ejections or arrests that may arise from the event. The space should have access to a back-of-house exit from the venue. Storage for security equipment radios, cameras, signage and magnetometers Adjacent to Command Post

Debriefing area

Where possible, First Responders should be provided with a room for briefings. And parking should be allocated for First Responder vehicles (police/fire/EMT) with easy access into back-of-house locations, including detention area and Unified Command Post.

Provide space for a workshop for maintenance staff to make repairs and small-scale construction

Loading Dock/Marshalling/Receiving

Marshalling Area

Provide marshalling area with enough room for concert road boxes storage and easy access from the stage for loading/unloading.

Loading Dock-Truck Positions

Two (2), separate and distinct loading docks from the commissary loading facility, as a minimum. Arrange for trucks to have direct access from street/entry to facility. (consider modification for smaller venue)

Loading Dock Location

Arrange dock so the deliveries have direct access/vision of the security office as well as a direct path to receiving/freight elevator for day-to-day deliveries. Alternative measures for receiving packages and shipments on non-event days and event days should be considered when designing the stadium

Also arrange so that dock has a straight, direct path to the stage (if provided) for speed of loading and unloading for events.

Staging Area

Provide show power at both sides of stage for greatest flexibility. Work with design team to identify loads of typical concert as biggest user of power.

Provide shore power at the loading dock for use by concert tour buses, broadcast trucks and/or event support. Coordinate with Chapter 6 Broadcast Requirements for media trucks.
